## **Ash Wednesday - 17th February**

Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, and although St Peter's, along with Salisbury Cathedral and many other churches, is not holding services in church, you have a number of options to mark the beginning of Lent. St Peter's will be streaming a Parish Eucharist on YouTube at 10.45am. The Bishop of Salisbury will be live streaming a service from the Cathedral at 5.30pm (go to [www.salisburycathedral.org.uk/live](http://www.salisburycathedral.org.uk/live)) and Poole and North Bournemouth Deanery is holding a service at 7pm on Zoom (details below from Canon Lucy Holt, Rural Dean).

### **Deanery Ash Wednesday Service**

You are very warmly invited to be part of the Deanery Ash Wednesday Service at 7pm on Zoom. Bishop Karen will be preaching and taking part in the service.

For those whose tradition is to use ash as part of the service we will be offering this. However, you will need to find your own ash and have it with you. To make Ash from an old palm cross I suggest you dry it out in the oven as much as possible. Then I normally set light to it in an old tin can outside and then sometimes use the end of something like a rolling pin to grind it down to make nicer ash. Please do not fret about this if it is too complicated for you and you want to mark yourself with a cross, use something else to symbolise this like some dirt.
